(Program of All-Inclusive Care)

Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE, a Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly, provides older adults and their caregivers with an innovative home and community-based care program. Participants enjoy the independence of living in their own home and staying in their own communities. This program offers the convenience and security of coordinated care and coverage by combining medical care, insurance and long-term community support services into one program.

- Participants aged 55 and older, residing in Erie County and Niagara County, NY
 receive high-quality care—including primary medical care, prescription drugs,
 nutrition services, physical and occupational therapy, and more. All services are
 provided or arranged by a team of specialists in geriatric care or care of older
 adults.
- To be eligible to enroll as a Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE participant, individuals must:
 - Be at least 55 years old
 - Live in Erie or Niagara counties in New York
 - Be certified as needing nursing facility level of care as determined by the New York State scoring tool, which includes requiring Fallon Health Weinberg-PACE long-term care services for more than 120 days
 - Be able to live safely in a community setting at the time of enrollment, as defined by the New York State Health and Safety Criteria
