- Require home and community-based services for more than 120 days and meet eligibility criteria established by the New York State Department of Health
- Be capable, at the time of enrollment, of safely remaining in your home and community without jeopardy to your health and safety, based upon criteria provided by the New York State Department of Health
- Have Medicaid or be Medicaid eligible
- Call 1-855-222-8350 to have a Conflict-Free Evaluation and Enrollment Center (CFEEC) nurse visit you to determine your eligibility.

To join a Medicaid Community-Based Managed Long Term Care Program, a Conflict-Free Evaluation and Enrollment Center (CFEEC) nurse must first visit you to determine your eligibility.

Effective March 2015, New York State implemented an independent and conflict-free long term services and supports evaluation system for new applicants residing in Erie and Niagara County who are in need of community based long term care services. New York State has partnered with a company called Maximus and they will serve as the independent and conflict-free entity providing evaluations, education and enrollment services. Managed Long Term Care (MLTC) plans receiving calls from Medicaid or pending Medicaid recipients seeking a plan assessment of reenrollment must be directed to the Conflict-Free Evaluation and Enrollment Center (CFEEC) at 1-855-222-8350.

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Fallon Health Weinberg-MLTC is a Managed Long Term Care plan created as a way to provide you the flexibility to meet your health care needs.

Our team will partner with you to establish services that will support and promote your wellness and independence.

We are committed to helping our members be independent and healthy.

Our goal is for you to continue to live safely in the community. Each member is assigned an RN Care Manager and a Care Team who:

- Work with members, doctors and caregivers to design an individualized plan of care
- Arrange and monitor services and care
- Coordinate medical and long term care with all providers
- Help with doctor's appointments, attendance at day programs, and arrange transportation to those services.

The Care Team works with providers and coordinates services not directly provided by Fallon Health Weinberg-MLTC or its network, like:

- Physician services
- Inpatient and outpatient services
- Hospital care
- Laboratory and radiology services
- Mental health services
- Alcohol and substance abuse services
- Chronic renal dialysis
- Emergency transportation

For the services we do not cover, the provider bills Medicare or Medicaid directly.
